Von Hertling Won't Discuss Their Views of Russian Treaty

HE DECLARED TO REICHSTAG

Said Russia Need Not Feel Ashamed of the Peace

Copenhagen, March 19.—Chancellor Von Hertling, on the first reading in the Reichstag of the peace treaty with Russia Monday, declared that he did not wish to discuss the opinions of German enemies regarding the treaty.

GERMANS SUFFERED IN COBLENZ RAID

London, March 19.—Fifty persons were killed and great damage was done by bombs dropped by allied airmen when they raided Coblenz, Germany, on March 12, according to a neutral traveler who arrived Monday at The Hague, The Times says.

BELGIANS COUNTERED

London, March 19.—Strong German efforts against the Belgian front, including the line near Nieupoort, which the Belgians recently took over from the French, penetrated the front defenders, but the Germans' success was short-lived.

GROUND GLASS IN BREAD.

Sand and Silica Also Found by Government Chemists.

New York, March 19.—Chemists of the national food administration have found ground glass, sand and silica in bread, baked in Germany, which the agency submitted to them for analysis by the federal food board, according to an announcement made yesterday by Arthur Williams, federal food administrator for New York City.

AVIATION FACILITIES.

One Killed at San Diego and Another at Fort Worth.

San Diego, Cal., March 19.—Coming out of a nose dive upside down, Flying Cadet Ralph T. Simpson, of the North Island aviation school here, was thrown out of his airplane yesterday and fell a hundred feet to his death in San Diego bay. The machine came down on top of Simpson as he struck the water. The body was recovered. Simpson was 27 years old and lived in Pasadena.
