BORE MESSAGE TO PRESIDENT.

So Says Alleged Hindu Plotter, on Trial in San Francisco, of Ghose Arrested in New York.

San Francisco, March 21.—A telegram of protest to President Wilson against the arrest in New York of Salsandra Nath Ghose, under indictment here in connection with an alleged conspiracy to overthrow British rule in India, was sent Tuesday by Tarik Nath Das, one of the principal Hindu defendants now on trial in the federal district court. The telegram requests immunity for Ghose, who, it was asserted by Das, was not within the jurisdiction of the United States courts when the conspiracy indictments were returned. Das wired the president that Ghose is one of three members of a special commission of an Indian nationalist party representing several millions of persons. The commission, he said, "has a special message for the United States assuring your government of India's co-operation in efforts to fulfill the aims and purposes of the United States in the war." Das requests that President Wilson afford Ghose opportunity to present his credentials and the special message to this government.

Vermont Baptist Laymen's Campaign.

When a church of 78 members raises \$300 inside of seven minutes for a special object it is a sign that times are changing. So they are in the Baptist denomination. Never in the history of the church have Vermont Baptist laymen hustled to accomplish a thing as they have been getting behind the drive to raise one million dollars before March 31. The men at Brattleboro started the campaign off by raising \$876 the first week of the drive, at the rate of \$125 per day. They expect to reach \$1,000 before they stop. The fifteen members of the church at Shady Hill pledged 73 per cent of their share at the hour of organization. They expect to "go over the top." Professor Raymond McFarland, the campaign director, is encouraged with the response that church laymen are making. Three-fourths of Vermont's \$7,000 have been pledged by forty churches; the complete success of the campaign will depend upon how well the smaller churches can respond. If they respond like Middlebury with \$300 in record time, or with the Shady Hill spirit, the big drive will be a success in Vermont.

Some of the other "over-the-top" churches and what they expect to raise are Burlington, \$600, Rutland and Bennington, \$500 each, Bellows Falls and North Bennington \$125 each, Bristol, Chester, Ludlow and Richford \$150 each, Montgomery Center and St. Albans, \$100 each. East Poultney reports "You can count on \$60 from this church," a 100 per cent. Nobody knows what Newport and West Derby will do, but it will be something worthy of their entrance into the city class. They expect to close their campaign March 24.
