Washington, D. C., Dec. 26.—To-day's casualty list contained 4,293 names, divided as follows: Killed in action, 83; died of wounds, 120; died of accident or other cause, 14; died from airplane accident, 3; died of disease, 202; wounded severely, 906; wounded (degree undetermined), 1,608; wounded slightly, 1,217; missing in action, 141.
