Richard H. Long of Massachusetts is relieved of a great responsibility of trying to make good those many promises he made in the pre-election campaign. That is, if the promises were really something more than scraps of paper incident to a political campaign.

Tuesday's election in Massachusetts leaves the question of leadership of the Democratic party in that state somewhat in doubt, but to all appearances David I. Walsh, United States senator, is the Kingpin of the lot at the present time albeit even he will find his course somewhat narrowed by the voice of the people.

The 10 Norwich university students who walked from Northfield to Middlebury to witness the football game between their college and Middlebury got some valuable military training in the line of pedal callisthenics, besides a great deal of experience. The perseverance of the 10 young cadets is something to be commended.

Again we hear that Germany is "near bankruptcy." It must be borne in mind that Germany is getting ready to pay the first installment of that huge indemnity, and that country is, consequently, feeling poor. Otherwise, Germany is probably making as fast progress as any other warring nation toward normal business, perhaps even faster than any other of the entire group of European nations.

THE GRAHAM PROCEEDINGS.

All things considered, the best and fairest way to all concerned in the Graham case is to have a full and fair trial before a jury of the former auditor's peers and to let that jury determine the innocence or guilt of the man on the charges brought in the indictment. By placing the case before a jury of fair-minded men, the state and the defending attorneys will virtually set the verdict up to the public, which will, in turn, be influenced by the weight of the testimony presented. The public, through the jury of 12 men, will determine what course it desires to follow in the case; and, after all has been said and done, the matter should rest in the hands of the people. Therefore, it would seem to be the reasonable action to proceed to the trial in Washington county court without further delays.

SUBMERGING THANKSGIVING DAY

If it is Gov. Clement's purpose to recommend to the Vermont legislature that the time-honored Thanksgiving day be wiped out, or merged with a celebration of armistice day, he will no doubt find that the people of Vermont will be strongly opposed to the plan. The custom of celebrating the harvest was established in New England back in 1621 when the Pilgrim fathers rendered thanks for the crops of the year, and it has been kept up with more or less regularity ever since that time. Here in New England it is an almost sacred habit to set aside the day albeit the significance of the observance has been lost sight of to a considerable extent; and since the days of Civil war it has been the practice of the presidents of the United States to set aside the last Thursday in November as Thanksgiving day, the governors of the state following suit in almost every case. To rob Thanksgiving day of its individuality by merging it with an international event, such as the celebration of the signing of the armistice, would be to deprive Americans of one of their finest traditions; and it would be, to New Englanders, almost a violation of the sacred things of the past. It is well enough to honor the first anniversary of the signing of the armistice by proclaiming a holiday and even to perpetuate the anniversary by setting aside a day for celebration in the years to come; but it is not according to the people's wish to submerge the identity of the peculiarly American Thanksgiving day in any way or to change the date of the observance of Thanksgiving day. So Gov. Clement would be better guided should he decide not to submit the matter to the legislature of Vermont.


