Happenings of Interest from Different Sections.

Vera Goodell of Mount Holly was fined \$25 and costs for running an auto without a license.

Wilfred L. Wing, aged 40, of Greenfield, Mass., who was injured in Bellows Falls last week when he fell from a staging, died in the hospital there Saturday.

Milton B. Hunt, for two years in charge of athletic and other activities at the Rutland Community house, has resigned as a director, the resignation to become effective Sept. 1.

During the heavy electrical storm of Friday evening in the vicinity of Danville, the steeple of the Baptist church at North Danville was struck by lightning, damaging the outside of the building to quite an extent.

Sunday's rain did \$2,000 damage in Brattleboro, \$4,000 in Marlboro and \$3,000 in Windham. Six small bridges were washed out or undermined between Windham and South Londonderry. The damage in Marlboro was largely to the new federal highway.

It has been decided to use in the new Brattleboro bridge none of the steel which fell into the Connecticut river June 16 and was bent. While it is thought much of the steel could be used, the engineer and superintendent of the construction company agreed to discard it.

Three cows owned by Frank H. Brooks and one owned by Clarence B. Weeks died on the golf links in St. Johnsbury last week of hemorrhagic septicemia, a form of blood poisoning. There have been two other cases in St. Johnsbury—a cow in the herd of George C. Cary and another at a Kirby farm.

Dennis Cutting, a conductor on the last car returning to Rutland from the south belt about midnight Saturday, was knocked unconscious by a male passenger whom he had reprimanded for insulting talk made to a group of girls sitting near him. The assailant and his companions left the car at once after the episode, but their names were known.

A Ford touring car and Ford runabout collided in Rutland at 2 o'clock Friday morning, the larger car, which is blamed for the accident, being reduced to junk and one of the passengers, Roy Denno of Brandon, losing much blood from cuts and bruises. The owners of the cars were not known in Rutland, but the car numbers were 15,487 on the touring car and 17,855 on the runabout.

Joseph Lemmah, aged 74 years, narrowly escaped sudden death as he was on the way to church in Enosburg Falls last Sunday. He was in front of his own home when struck by an automobile being driven by Prosper Smith of the same place. He was made unconscious and a physician found one ear nearly severed, a severe bump on the back of his head, his left shoulder and arm badly wounded and his right knee hurt. His condition is serious.


