The German potash salts are not caustic potash, hence they do not dissipate ammonia by hastening fermentation when applied to manure. Instead, they form a compound with the ammonia, thus helping to keep it from washing.

Apples can be kept in cellars better than above ground, provided they be not brought in contact with the soil. This is sure to injure their flavor, though it prevents either rotting or wilting from contact with changing air.

Peas and bean straw are much liked by sheep, and, as they are somewhat more nutritious than hay, it is desirable to grow them for the flock. Beans are not eaten with relish at once, but the sheep soon get accustomed to them, and then eat them readily.

It is very rare of late years that a season is found when there is good pasture all through the year. Usually the dry spell comes late in the summer or early in the fall, just at the time when the best soiling crops are ready to help out the deficiencies of pasture.

Two-year-old steers are considered very profitable by those who have bred for choice beef, but a scrub steer would not reach the weight of a pure-bred steer in four years, if at all.

An experienced farmer claims that he has prevented loss from cholera in hogs by feeding linseed meal and a variety of food so as to keep them in good condition, thus lessening the liability to disease.

Scours in calves is the bane of the dairyman who aims to raise them, especially after taking them from their dams early. One cause of scours is that the calf is permitted to swallow the milk too rapidly.


