Paris Dispatch to New York World.  
A great civic movement for the "cleaning up" of Paris is on foot under the direction of M. Urbain Gohier, the noted editor of the Paris Journal, and other prominent men. No one in the future is to be given any pretext whatever to asperse the name of France or its capital with the accusation of decadence or degeneration.  
The Paris of the foreign tourist will after the war be a thing of the past. The gay Babalon, the Ville Lumiere, the city of a form of roystering gaiety the very thought of which shocked prudish persons the world over, is to be cleaned up forever. That Paris is to die with the war. Its demise will be all the easier since, as a matter of fact, it never really existed.  
Paris, the great city of light, of marvelous architecture, of art and beauty, and many attractions which no other city can rival, never in reality was anything but a serious city. The sinful notions regarding it had their origin largely in the imagination of the foreign visitors, ignorant of the elementary facts regarding Paris, incapable of judging what their eyes beheld and unacquainted with the necessary variety of the modes of life of a great city.  
The idea was foisted also by the works of certain French novelists usually, however, in a vein of satire which was lost on the duller foreigner.
