**NOTICE SCHOOL ELECTION.**

A petition containing one-fourth of the freeholders of the district described below, said school district being in Mineral Springs Township, Richmond county, North Carolina, and being known as Norman School District No. 8, asking for an election to be held in said district, said petition having been duly endorsed by the Board of Education, the following order was unanimously passed, to wit:

Pursuant to said petition and of the School Laws of North Carolina, we, the Board of Commissioners for Richmond county, North Carolina, being in regular monthly session on Monday, June 7th, 1920, a quorum being present, do hereby call and order an election to be held on Saturday, August 21st, 1920, at the School House in said Norman School District No. 8, Mineral Springs Township, in said county and state are in favor of issuing bonds for the purpose of building, rebuilding and repairing school-houses and furnishing the same with suitable equipment.

The amount of bonds proposed to be issued is \$12,000.00 bearing interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, to run 20 years, and the proposed tax rate is 30 cents on the one hundred dollars valuation of property and 90 cents on the poll.

A new registration is hereby ordered and called for said school election in said school district.

The registration books will open Saturday, July 17th, 1920, and close on Saturday, August 7th, 1920, for the registration of all voters in said district. The registration and election shall be had according to law now in force governing same.

R. V. Ussery is hereby appointed registrar, and T. M. Ledbetter and J. L. Austin are hereby appointed poll holders to conduct said election.
