The home grown crops and those coming from New Mexico are said to be some of the best ever received in this city. The home grown equal say that have been sold here, local dealers say. They are also selling at three cents a pound.

Many Crops Good.

Home grown lima beans, cauliflower, cucumbers and egg plants are coming in big orders. The crops are fine this season and sell at practically the same price as a year ago. Lima beans are selling for 20 cents a pound, cauliflower 25 cents a head, cucumbers at five and ten cents apiece, and egg plants at 15 cents apiece. The shipped in cucumbers sell as high as 25 cents. The difficulty experienced in getting pickling cucumbers is still encountered. The local vines were burned by the lack of rain, and the few that did turn out were sold right from the patch, and did not come to the markets.

Eggs and butter have jumped

two cents since a week ago. Eggs are 67 cents per dozen as compared to 65 last week, and butter is 67 cents as compared to 65 cents a week ago.

Apples Good.

Although the home grown apples are plentiful and good, Rock Island merchants claim that the growers do not take care of the trees, and should they, the output here would be enormous. Many growers are not selling their apples, but giving them away. At the markets they sell at six cents a pound, while the shipped in variety sell at ten cents per pound.

Sweet corn remains at the same price. Since the first of the season corn has been from 25 to 30 cents a dozen. Today it is selling at 25 cents. The evergreen and the country gentlemen varieties are coming in now, the Golden Bantam having gone.
