...a statement to make about 1 o'clock this afternoon.

Chicago, Oct. 1.—Charles A. Conway, owner of the Chicago White Sox, says State Attorney Hoyne to investigate last year's world's series immediately after the conclusion of the games. Hoyne said today after his return here from New York.

Hoyne's office conducted the investigation for three or four days and found enough evidence to satisfy him that the series was crooked, he said. Not enough evidence, however, to prove the fact, he added.

Prosecutor Makes Statement.
Mr. Hoyne said:

"I have been in New York and, of course, know nothing about the actual facts in the case. I made no demand that the investigation be halted. I simply asked the grand jury not to take any action until I had a chance to go over the evidence and check up on some evidence that I expect to get. I did not attempt to influence the action of the grand jurors. They are, of course, the final judges in the matter."

"I simply asked them to allow me time to be advised as to the facts which have developed. Immediately after the world's series Comiskey asked me to investigate and said that he would pay the expenses of the investigation."

"I told him we would be glad to help him and that if we obtained evidence we would prosecute. We worked for three or four days on the investigation and obtained enough evidence to satisfy us that the series was crooked, but we did not obtain sufficient evidence to act."

Mr. Hoyne said that he would give out another statement later in the day.

Brooklyn "Probe."
New York, Oct. 1.—(United Press.)—Investigation to ascertain whether any clique of professional gamblers has attempted to corrupt the Brooklyn club, which will play in the world series beginning Tuesday, was expected to be brought to a conclusion today by District Attorney Lewis of Kings county.

Lewis said today he was not investigating actual corruption of the Brooklyn club, which, so far as he knows, is absolutely honest to the last man, but is probing the report that gamblers plotted to attempt to corrupt some of the players.

After questioning Manager Wilbert Robinson and others of the Brooklyn players today, Lewis plans to issue a formal statement of his findings.

Herrmann Has Portfolio.
August Herrmann, president of the Cincinnati team and former chairman of the national commission, appeared at State's Attorney Hoyne's office this morning with a portfolio of documents and papers relative to the cases of Hal Chase and Lee Magee, who were driven from organized baseball last year.

Herrmann had been requested by the grand jury to bring the papers.

Question Brooklyn Players.
New York, Oct. 1.—Because of the press of other business, District Attorney Lewis of Brooklyn today announced he would not be able to complete his examination today of Brooklyn National league baseball players in connection with reports that an attempt had been made to "fix" the approaching world's series.

Mr. Lewis said that he had arranged a conference with President Charles H. Ebbets of the Brooklyn club for tomorrow, when other players will be questioned. He said he probably would make a statement tomorrow, or as soon as the examination of the players is completed.

Three of the Brooklyn players—Outfielder "Hy" Meyers, Infielder James Johnston and Pitcher George Mohart—were questioned today by Assistant District Attorney Caldwell. No statement was issued as to what transpired at the conference.

When the players left the district attorney's office they were greeted with cheers by a large crowd gathered at the entrance to the building.
