Have Two Hundred New Members Reported for Work of Agriculture.

Members engaged in starting members for the Rock Island county farm bureau have extended their campaign through to the end of this week so that every prospect can be reached. The total number reported signed up to Monday night was 146. The canvassers did not work Tuesday, being called into conference in Chicago and yesterday it was too wet. Today, however, the work was renewed with every indication that the final report will show about two hundred additional members for the bureau.

Palmer R. Edgerton, county agent, is enthusiastic about the prospects of the bureau for a great work with nearly every farmer in the county lined up. Two hundred new members will make the membership about 95 per cent of the total number of eligibles.

RELEASE CARS TO MIDDLE WEST

Illinois and Other Central States Should Commence To Get Coal Supply.

Washington, Oct. 28. (United Press).—About two thousand coal cars will be released to the middle west today, it was estimated here, as a result of the interstate commerce commission lifting the order which gave preference to coal movements for the northwest via Lake Erie.

Ohio, Indiana, Illinois and other central states should commence to get their coal supply quickly now, it was expected.
