**IRON VETERAN AND PROMINENT CITIZEN PASSES**

John Samuelson, who had lived in Locality nearly 70 years, died at his home here Wednesday.

Orion, Nov. 4.—A resident of this locality for 65 years and a leading citizen of Orion, John Samuelson, aged 85, a veteran of the Civil war, died at his home here Wednesday.

Funeral services will be held in the Methodist church at 10:30 Saturday morning, conducted by Rev. Theodore Moberg of Andover and Rev. Sidney Guthrie, pastor. R. H. Graham post, Grand Army of the Republic, of Moline, of which Mr. Samuelson was a member, will hold a ceremony in the church.

Mr. Samuelson was born in Asherrind, Sweden, Nov. 15, 1815. The family came to America in 1851, and after a year in Buffalo, N. Y., removed to this locality. In 1861 Mr. Samuelson enlisted in Company C, 43rd Illinois volunteer infantry. He
