ALEX DESOLAND IS CALLED AT CHICAGO HOME
Former Rock Islander, Well Known Here, Dies Saturday Evening After Year's Illness.
Alexander De Soland, aged 70 years, for 27 years a roadmaster on the Burlington and a former member of the Rock Island Library and school boards, died Saturday evening at his home in Chicago, 3833 Van Buren street. Mr. De Soland had been failing for the last year and was seriously ill for the last

two months. He moved to Chicago from Rock Island eight years ago. Mr. De Soland was born in Denmark in 1850 and came to this country in 1874. He was a graduate of the military school in Copenhagen, and served in the Franco-Prussian war under General Chaney, as aide-de-camp. Mr. De Soland came to Rock Island in 1885 as roadmaster on the Beardstown and Sterling divisions of the Burlington, where he worked until 1912, when he retired and moved to Chicago.

While in this city Mr. De Soland served on the library board and the Rock Island school board for several years. He was vestryman and junior and senior warden of the Trinity Episcopal church for a number of years. He was married to Miss Meta Schrader of Joliet in that city 22 years ago. When in Rock Island the De Solands resided at 719 Twenty-third street. The widow is the only survivor. Mr. De Soland was a member of Trio lodge No. 57, A. F. & A. M. of this city. Funeral services were

held at 3 o'clock this afternoon, with burial at Graceland cemetery, Chicago.
