Holiday Gets Cold Feet - An attempted holdup of the Lage drug store on Monday night, when the streets fell on Wednesday night when the lone bandit lost his nerve and bed, as Will Lage, the proprietor, made a leap for the rear door to summon help. Nothing was taken. Mr. Lage described the gunman as being of medium size, of dark complexion, thin face, wearing a dark overcoat and hockey cap. He was about 25 years old, Mr. Lage said.

Hurt While Coasting - In the first serious, though not fatal coasting accident of the season Wednesday afternoon, William Jewett, 12 years old, 813 Iowa street, sustained bruises and abrasions which have resulted in his confinement. His sled crashed into the machine of Captain T. Hobbs at the intersection of Iowa and Eighth and a Half streets. Young Jewett was coasting down Iowa street between Eighth and Ninth streets, while Captain Hobbs was driving his car east on Eighth and a Half street. The boy's sled collided with the automobile and was demolished.

Former Arrested - After being at liberty eight months with a warrant charging him with false drawing of a check against him, Theodore Bernhoft of Denison, Iowa, was caught yesterday by the man who swore out the information - A. G. McMann. The check was drawn last April and when it was returned marked "no funds" the information against the man was filed. Yesterday morning McMann drove his car to the filling station at Fifth and Main streets and saw the fugitive having his car filled at the same station.

Hold Woman for Bootlegging - Now that women have been granted equal rights with men they have entered the bootlegging field in competition with the men of the species. Mrs. W. H. Adams, aged 25, of Muscatine, was arrested yesterday by Deputy U. S. Marshal T. F. Kenney, on a charge of selling intoxicating liquor. The woman was brought to Davenport yesterday and held under bonds to the grand jury.

Give Kahl Gift - Believing that such an important event in Davenport's history as the completion of the Kahl building should not be allowed to pass by without some sort of recognition of gratitude to its builders, friends of H. C. Kahl, assembled at a dinner party Wednesday evening in beautiful Terrace Gardens, presented Mr. Kahl with a handsome loving cup. The cup, massive silver piece, measured 22 inches in height, bore the following inscription: "To H. C. Kahl, from a few of your friends as a token of appreciation for your faith in Davenport, December, 1920." The presentation remarks were given by E. F. Adler and Mr. Kahl feelingly responded.

Death Record - Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Swift, a former resident of Davenport, died at Ashbury hospital, Minneapolis, Wednesday morning at the age of 63 years. Mr. Swift left Davenport ten years ago, 20.
