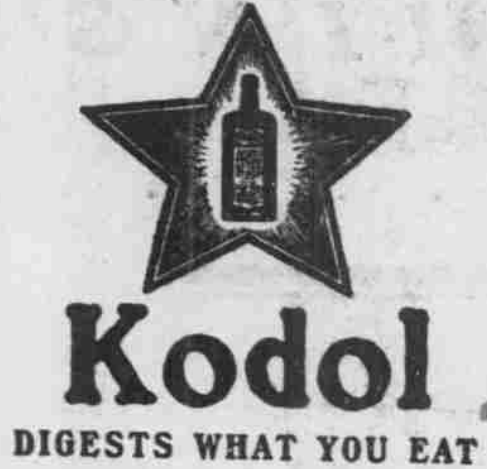

MUNICIPAL MATTERS.

City Council room, Rock Island, Aug. 29.—The council met in special session at 2 p. m., Mayor McConchie presiding, and all the aldermen present except Birkel.

The clerk read the call for the special meeting, which was for the purpose of inspecting the Fifteenth street paving and transacting such other business as might properly come before the meeting.

The clerk read a petition from Channon, Perry & Co., for sewer and water connections, for J. O. Freed, E. T. Beck, W. T. Boggess, all on Seventeenth street, between Ninth and Tenth avenues; also for Carl Roehow, on Fourth avenue and Twelfth street.

Ald. Benson moved that the petition be referred to the sewer committee with power to act. Carried.

Ald. Bloehlinger moved that the council take a recess to inspect the Fifteenth street paving. Carried.

On reassembling Ald. Anderson moved that the paving on Fifteenth street be accepted provided that the contractors repaired any defects which may appear with 60 days and move the catch basin on the north side of Fifteenth street and Eleventh avenue, within the sidewalk line. Carried unanimously.

Ald. Anderson moved that the mayor and city clerk be authorized to settle with the contractors, and issue the necessary bonds. Carried unanimously.

Ald. Robbins moved that the city engineer be instructed to proceed with the necessary steps to open a ditch on Eleventh avenue at Fifteenth street, and as far west as is necessary to provide surface drainage. Carried unanimously.

Ald. Bloehlinger moved that the city engineer be instructed to have a manhole placed at the west side of Second street and Seventh avenue. Carried unanimously.

Ald. Bloehlinger moved that the petition of Louis Mosenfelder for the extension of water mains from Fourteenth to Eighteenth avenues, on Thirtieth street be granted provided that Mr. Mosenfelder pay \$200 toward the cost of the improvement. Carried.

Adjourned on motion of Ald. Kennedy.
