Low pressures prevail from the north Atlantic coast westward to the upper Mississippi valley and light precipitation has occurred in the middle Atlantic states and New England. Rain has again fallen on the extreme north Pacific coast. A further rise in temperature is noted in most sections east of the Rockies, though light frost extended southeastward to Tampa. The pressure is highest in the Rocky Mountain region, with the crest of the high over Washington and British Columbia. The eastward movement of the northwestern high will be attended by fair weather in this vicinity tonight and Friday, with somewhat cooler Friday.
