### WEATHER OBSERVATIONS

The storm center which was yesterday over Iowa has moved north-eastward to upper Michigan, attended by light precipitation in the central valleys and by heavier snow or rain from the lake region to New York and New England, with gales in the lake region. This disturbance has also caused a rise in temperature on the Atlantic slope but it has been followed by colder weather in the territory from the eastern Rocky mountain slope to the Mississippi valley. Rain or snow on the north Pacific coast is resulting from a moderate low which is over British Columbia. An area of high pressure is central over northern California and is ever-spreading the Rocky mountain region. The continued eastward movement of the western high will be attended by fair weather in this vicinity tonight and Wednesday, with colder tonight.


