Weather Bureau
Aears of low pressure are central this morning over New England and Arizona and a few scattered showers and thunderstorms have occurred in New Mexico, western Kansas, the lower lake region, the St. Lawrence, the Ohio and the lower Mississippi valleys, with a rainfall of 1.66 at Roswell. The western area of high pressure is central over Kansas and its attendant cool weather has extended eastward to the Alleghenies and southward to Texas and Arkansas. Warm weather continues on the Atlantic coast and the temperature has risen in the Rocky mountain region and the middle and upper Missouri valley. Owing to the presence of the Kansas high, fair and warmer weather is indicated for this vicinity tonight and Thursday. Friday will be fair probably.


