REPORT SHOWS A MONEY NEED FOR BUILDING LOANS

In making a nation-wide survey of building conditions, the United States department of labor recently sent out questionnaires to several thousand building and loan associations.

Returns disclosed that more than 40 per cent of the building associations have not sufficient available funds to meet the desirable applications for loans that are coming in as a result of the shortage of houses and the general revival of construction activities.

The movement to establish federal home loan banks is approved by a majority of the associations that returned answers to the questionnaires.

According to recent estimates made by the division of public works and construction development, of the department's information and education service, there are now in the United States 2,369 building and loan associations with paid-in capital stock amounting to \$1,503,770,848.

FIRE INSURANCE FIRMS TO GIVE RETURN ON TAX

State Orders Illinois Companies to Refund the 10 Per Cent Surcharge Collected.

Fire insurance companies of Illinois which collected a surcharge of 10 per cent during the period of the war will be instructed by the state department of trade and commerce to return the amount to insureds or lose their charters.

This statement was made by William H. Boys, state director, who also declared that the notices would be sent out soon and that companies will be given a reasonable length of time in which to comply with the order.

The action is taken in compliance with a resolution adopted by the Illinois general assembly, which was offered by Representative Lee "Neil" Browne of Ottawa. The resolution charges that the surcharge of 10 per cent added by fire insurance companies during the period of the war resulted in the collection upwards of two million dollars.

The rates charged by insurance companies of the state are said to have been fixed by a rate making company. A bill empowering the state to establish a rate making bureau, under the direction of the state department of trade and commerce, was vetoed by Governor Lowden.


