 The introduction of pepsin as a re-  
 medial agent effected a complete revo-  
 lution in the method of restoring to  
 normal the ailments which in the old  
 days were classed in a group as dys-  
 pepsia.

If physicians were to observe anni-  
 versaries of the discovery of remedies  
 which had proved a blessing to man-  
 kind the entire profession would unite  
 in remembering the fiftieth anniver-  
 sary of the first manufacture of pepsin  
 in this country.

Just half a century ago the late John  
 Carrick, the eminent physiological  
 chemist and the father of physiological  
 products in the United States, made  
 possible a new epoch in American  
 medicine by producing the first pepsin.

Pepsin had been made in a small  
 way in Europe before Mr. Carrick's  
 enterprise caused it to be introduced  
 here, as it was originally suggested  
 by Dr. Corvisart of Paris. The qual-  
 ity was so poor, however, that its use  
 was distinctly limited.
