NEGRO SOLDIERS EXECUTED

Thirteen members of the 24th Infantry executed at Fort Sam Houston, Texas, on the 11th Dec. convicted of participating in the riots at Houston, Texas, Aug 23, last.

No announcement has been made when the 41 negroes given life sentences by the courtmartial will be taken to Fort Leavenworth.

Of the others, four were sentenced to dishonorable discharge from the army, forfeiture of all pay and allowances due, and prison terms of two years and two years and six months. Five were acquitted and sent to join their commands.

In spite of the executions and announcement of the other sentences to day, the riot at Houston is not a closed incident. Investigation is still in progress and it is expected additional courtmartial will follow.

The executions created some demonstration among the progress of the trial, in the nature of mournings at a few negro churches. Crowds at these however were small.


