of trustees of El Centro school district,
in the county of San Diego, state of California,
it is advisable to call an election
and submit to the electors of said district
the question of voting a special tax
to the amount of (\$1500) Fifteen
Hundred dollars, to furnish school facilities
for the school district to maintain a
school, for building and furnishing a
school house.
