11 S to the S W corner of T 10 S, R 11 E, thence south along range line between ranges 10 and 11 E to the N E corner of section 24, T 14 S, R 10 E, thence east along the section line to the N E corner of section 24, T 14 S, R 10 E, thence south along the range line between ranges 14 and 15 E to the S E corner of section 24, T 15 S, R 13 E, thence west along the south lines of sections 24, 23, 22, 21, T 15 S, R 14 E to the S W corner of said section 21, thence south to the east 1-4 corner of section 29, T 15 S, R 14 E, thence west along the center line of said section 29 and 30 and section 25, T 15 S, R 13 E to the center of said section 25, thence south along the center lines of said section 25 and 36 to the south 1-4 corner of said section 36, T 15 S, R 13 E, thence west along the south boundary of T 15 S, R 14 E to the S W corner of Section 33, same township and range, thence north along the section lines to the S E corner of section 17, T 15 S, R 13 E, thence east along the section lines to the place beginning.

Excepting—
Sections 17 and 18, and south 1-2 of sections 7 and 8 and N 1-2 of sections 19 and 20, all of T 15 S, R 14 E.

Section 27. The boundaries of the several school districts lying and being within the proposed new county of Imperial shall be and remain as the same have heretofore been established and no change therein is made by this ordinance except as to the school district of Abbee and the boundaries of said Silsbee school district are hereby changed and amended as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of range line between ranges 8 and 9 E and the southern boundary of the United States and running thence north along the range line between ranges 8 & 9 E to the N W corner of T 9 S, R 9 E, thence east along the north line of township 9 S, to the N E corner of section 5, T 8 S, R 12 E, thence south along the range line a distance of 32 miles more or less to the S E corner of section 8, T 8 S, R 12 E, thence west along the range line 2 miles north to the S E corner of section 12, T 14 S, R 11 E, thence south along the range line between ranges 11 E and 12 E to the S E corner of Sec 1, T 16 S, R 11 E, thence north 7 1-2 miles, more or less, along the range line to the south 1-4 line of sections 5, T 16 S, R 13 E, thence north one mile more or less, to the center of section 5, thence east one mile, more or less, to the center of section 4, T 8 S, R 13 E, thence north one half mile more or less to the north quarter of said section, thence east 1 1-2 mile to the N E corner of said section 4, thence south one mile to the S E corner of section 4, thence east one mile to the N E corner of section 10, T 16 S, R 13 E, thence south 5 miles to the S E corner of section 34, T 16 S, R 13 E, thence west along the township line between townships 16 S and 17 S to the N corner of T 17 S, R 9 E, thence south along the range line between ranges 9 E and 10 E to the southern boundary line of the United States, thence westerly along the southern boundary of the United States to the place of beginning.

Section 28. The proposed new county of Imperial county is hereby divided into five supervisorial districts which shall be as follows:

Section 29. The first supervisorial district shall be bounded as follows: Commencing at the intersection of range line between ranges 8 and 9 E, B. M. and the boundary line between the U. S. and Mexico and running north along said range line to its intersection with the 4th standard line, thence east along said line between T 16 and 17 south to the south corner section 35, T 16 S, R 14 E, thence north along the west side of said section to the N W corner of, thence east along the north lines of sections 35 and 36, T 16 S, R 14 E to the E corner said section 36, thence east along the west lines of section 30 and 39, T 16 S, R 15 E to the northwest corner of said section 19, thence east 18 miles more or less along the section line to the S W corner section 18, T 16 S, R 15 E, thence north along the range line between ranges 17 and 18 E to the corner section 6, T 16 S, R 18 E, thence east along the T line to the N E corner section 1, T 16 S, R 18 E, thence north to the N W corner T 15 S, R 19 E, thence running east along the township line between T 14 and 15 S to the N E corner T 15 S, R 21 E, thence south on range line between ranges 21 and 22 E, point directly east of the south line of section 10, T 16 S, R 21 E on the Yuma Indian reservation, thence east to the eastern boundary of the state of California, thence in a southwesterly direction along the eastern boundary of the state of California to the point where the eastern boundary of the state of California intersects the southern boundary of the U. S., thence west along the eastern boundary of the U. S. to the place of beginning.

Section 30. The second supervisorial district shall be bounded as follows: Commencing at the S W corner T 16 S, R 15 E, SBM and running thence north along the range line between ranges 8 and 9 E to the N W corner section 19, T 16 S, R 9 E, thence East 26 miles more or less along the section lines to the N E corner of section 20, T 15 S, R 13 E, thence south along the east lines of sections 20-29 and 32, T 15 S, R 13 E, to the E corner of said section 32, thence north along the township line to the north corner of section 1, T 16 S, R 13 E, thence north along the center lines sections 6 and 25, T 15 S, R 13 E to the of said section 25, thence east along the center line of said section 25 to the center lines of sections 30 and 39, T 16 S, R 14 E to the east quarter of said section 29, thence north along the east line said section 29 to the corner thereof, thence east along the lines of sections 28, 27, 26, 25, T 14 E, to the N E corner said section 25, thence south along the range line between ranges 14 and 15 E to the S

E corner of section 25, T 16 S, R 14 E, thence west along the south lines of said section 25 and also section 26, T 16 S, R 14 E to the S W corner said section 26, thence south to the S E corner section 34, T 16 S, R 14 E, thence west along the township lines between townships 16 and 17 south to the place of beginning.

Section 31. The third supervisorial district shall be bounded as follows:

Commencing at the S W corner of section 18, T 15 S, R 9 E, SBM, and running thence north along the range line between ranges 8 and 9 east, SBM, to the N W corner of T 9 S, R 9 E, thence east along the north line of T 9 S, to the N E corner of T 9 S, R 12 E, thence south along the range line between ranges 12 and 13 E, to the S E corner T 40 S, R 12 E, thence west along line between T 10 and T 11 S, to the S W corner of T 10 S, R 11 E, thence south along range line between ranges 10 and 11 E, to the N E corner of section 24, T 14 S, R 10 E, thence east along the section lines to the N E corner of section 24, T 14 S, R 14 E, thence south along the range line between ranges 14 and 15 E, to the S E corner of section 24, T 15 S, R 14 E, thence west along the south lines of sections 24, 23, 22, 21, T 15 S, R 14 E, to the S W corner of said section 21, thence south to the east 1-4 corner of section 29, T 15 S, R 14 E, thence west along the center line of said section 29 and 30, and section 25, T 15 S, R 13 E, to center of said section 25, thence south along the center lines of said section 25 and 36 to the south 1-4 corner of said section 36, T 15 S, R 13 E, thence west along the south boundary of T 15 S, R 13 E, to the S W corner of section 33, same township and range, thence north along the section lines to the S E corner of section 17, T 16 S, R 13 E, thence west along the section lines to the place of beginning.

Section 32. The fourth supervisorial district shall be bounded as follows:

Commencing at the S W corner section 18, T 14 S, R 11 E, thence running north along the range line between ranges 10 E and 11 E, to the N W corner(T 11 S, range 11 E, thence running east along the T line between T 10 and 11 S, to the S W corner T 10 S, R 13 E, thence running north along the range lines between ranges 12 E and 13 E to the N W corner T 9 S, R 13 E, thence running east along north line T 9 S, to the N E corner T 9 S, R 17 E, thence running south along the range line between R 17 E and 18 E to the S E corner section 24, T 12 S, R 17 E, thence running west along the section lines to the S W corner section 19 T 12 S, R 16 E thence south along the range line between R 15 E and 16 E to the S E corner section 13, T 14 S, R 15 E, thence west 30 miles more or less along the section lines to the place of beginning.

Section 33. The fifth supervisorial district shall be bounded as follows:

Commencing at the S W corner section 18, T 16 S, R 15 E, SBM, thence running north along the range line between ranges 14 E and 15 E to the N W corner section 19, T 14 S, R 15 E, thence running east along the north line of sections 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 and 24, T 14 S, R 15 E, to the N E corner said section 24, thence north on the range lines between ranges 15 E and 16 E to the N W corner section 30, T 12 S, R 16 E, thence east twelve miles more or less along the section lines to the N E corner section 25, T 12 S, R 17 E, thence running north along the range line between ranges 17 E and 18 E to the N W corner T 9 S, R 18 E, thence east along the north line of said T 9 S to the eastern boundary of the state of California, thence following said eastern boundary of the state of California in a southerly direction to a point thereon directly east of the south line of section 10, T 16 S, R 21 E, thence west to a point on the range line between R 21 E and 22 E, or said line produced, thence north along said range line to the N W corner T 15 S, R 22 E, thence west along the T line between T 14 S and 15 S to the southwest corner of

T 14 S, R 19 E, thence south along range line between ranges 18 and 19 E to S E corner T 15 S, R 18 E, thence west along T line between T 15 S and 16 S to south-west corner T 15 S, R 18 E thence south along range line between ranges 17 E and 18 E to S E corner section 13, T 14 S, R 17 E, thence west 18 miles more or less along section lines to place of beginning.

Section 34. The proposed new county of Imperial Co. shall be divided into five road districts, to be known respectively as Road District No. One, Road District No. Two, Road District No. Three, Road District No. Four and Road District No. Five, and the boundaries of Road District No. One shall be the same as the boundaries of the First Supervisorial District, as herein defined. The boundaries of Road District No. Two shall be the same as the boundaries of the Second Supervisorial District as herein defined. The boundaries of Road District No. Three shall be the same as the boundaries of the Third Supervisorial District herein defined: The boundaries of Road District No. Four shall be the same as the boundaries of the Fourth Supervisorial District as herein defined. The boundaries of Road District No. Five shall be the same as the boundaries of the Fifth Supervisorial District as herein defined.

Section 35. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the day of , 1907, and the same is hereby ordered published for one week in the Imperial Valley Press, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published weekly in the county of San Diego.

Section 36. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
