FROM OLD MEXICO

Mexican Officials See the Valley and Inspect Heading at Calexico

A party of high Mexican officials visited Calexico last week and were the guests of General Manager H. T. Cory, of the California Development Company; A. F. Andrade, of the Mexican Sociedad de Irrigacion, and J. E. Carillo, engineer in charge of construction for the Southern Pacific company. The party consisted of Senor Andres Aldasore, assistant secretary of the interior of the republic of Mexico; Senora Aldasore, wife of the assistant secretary; Senor dePuga, a member of the Mexican boundary commission, and his wife. Harry Chandler and Mr. Anderson, of the California-Mexico Land and Cattle company, and C. E. Tait, of the agricultural department, were also members of the party.

The points of interest in the valley were visited and a special car trip made to the headings where the great work accomplished by the C. D. Company, under the management of Mr. Cory, were inspected with great interest.

The members of the party expressed themselves as very much impressed by the apparent richness of the Imperial valley.

Picks His Men

Below is published a communication of I. W. Gleason's, wherein he appoints the committee in accordance with the resolutions passed by the Settler's Mutual Protective Association. Mr. Gleason intended this to be published last week but it was received too late for that issue of the Press:

The Imperial Valley Press

In accordance with the resolution passed by the Settler's Mutual Protective Association at their meeting at El Centro on Tuesday the 16th inst. I have appointed Mr. R. H. Benton as Vice Pres. and Mr. Tom Beach and J. B. Parazette as committeemen, who together will constitute the local executive committee for the Water Co. No. 1, district.

Any person in this district whose claim is jumped or contested will appear before this committee and state their case, and if found by them on investigation to be a bonified case it will be so reported to the General executive committee.

If approved by the general committee the case will be taken up by them and the members rights defended by whatever course of action may seem to them to be most proper under the existing circumstances.

This course of action appears to me to be most wise because we find our rights invaded by a lot of claim jumpers who in order to create public sympathy for their nefarious work have attacked the honor of the whole people of this valley, and who like the thief who sets up the cry of "stop thief" to draw attention away from himself, they have set up the claim that it was the big land owners and fraudulent entrymen they were after (if there be any such) while they speculate in contests and search out every possible technicality by which bonified land claimants can be deprived of their holdings.
