

THEN AND NOW

Reminiscences of San Bernardino Business College

When the San Bernardino Business College passed into the hands of the present owners less than two years ago the school had more room than it knew what to do with and a number of the rooms had been rented out for other purposes. To-day every available foot of space is taxed to its utmost to accommodate the increased attendance. The question then was, what to do with the extra room. The question now is, how to get room to accommodate the pupils. Although the school had been running for years it had only two teachers. Now it has five specialists. It then had nine second hand typewriters rented. It now owns 40 new machines of the best makes. It then had no business offices or banks. To-day its students learn business office work, banking, etc., as thoroughly as in the best banks or business concerns of California. The school was then suspended two months every year. It now runs the entire year without vacation. It then depended on a local patronage. It now attracts patronage from Oregon to Mexico and many other states. Then no one out of town ever heard of the school. Now people from a distance hear of the town on account of the school. Then, if students wished to take a civil service examination they had to pay railroad and hotel fare off somewhere else to get it. Now they can take civil service examinations here for 56 different government positions. Those have been arranged for by the San Bernardino Business College and this is the only school in California making a specialty of coaching for this work and assisting young people to secure government positions.
