

AUTOMOBILE ROAD

Diego Chamber of Commerce Approves Project
 Directors of the San Diego Chamber of Commerce have indicated the project for an automobile road connecting San Diego with Imperial Valley. It was led by one of the directors, the Union, that a company Imperial would put on an automobile stage line between the city and San Diego, making trips each way, if San Diego County would put so much of road in condition as lies west of the mountains. It was also that the principal item of expense would be the road between Campo and Jacumba, which it was thought could be in first-class condition for \$100,000. It was also pointed out such a road would be used by many tourists, who might desire to make a trip through the desert country and on to the desert. Pending the completion of a railroad to the Colorado river it was held that the stage automobile line was particularly to be desired.
