

First Picture of the Battleship 'New Mexico,' Which Will Be Launched Early This Fall

The battleship New Mexico already is under construction at the New York navy yard. The ship, whose name for this state was secured through the efforts of A. A. Jones, first assistant secretary of the interior, is one of three authorized at the second session of the sixty-third congress. She will be launched early this fall, the exact date not yet being fixed, and will join the fleet in which she is assigned early in the autumn of 1917. The three vessels are the largest warships either in commission or designed by any navy of the world, displacing 32,000 tons. The navy department believes they are of a design superior to any contemporary or previously designed vessel. Each ship will mount twelve 14-inch 50 caliber rifles in four turrets. These are of the most approved type. The vessels will be heavily armored, and, as they will burn oil as fuel, will have a very large cruising radius. The New Mexico is distinguished from her sister ships and from all other war vessels in that she will be electrically driven. This innovation was decided upon by the bureau of steam engineering after exhaustive tests on the collier Jupiter which demonstrated the economy and efficiency of this method of propulsion. The department of the navy thinks so well of the innovation, Secretary Daniels has written Mr. Jones, that it will be used on two other battleships, though the New Mexico will be the first.
