## A Three-Crop Country.

We are doing business in a two, three and four-crop country, and the thrifty farmers of the Carolinas are furnishing evidence and results every day. We know of a farm of truckers who are demonstrating the advantages of partnership farming. Everybody is familiar with the fact that men go into co-partnership to merchandise, but in this country there are also agricultural firms. We have never heard of one that has gone into the hands of the receiver. On the contrary, we hear of operations like those of one firm at least which furnishes us a fine example of the two, three and four-crop farming methods of this part of the nation's garden spot. This season they produced on 21 acres of land 800 crates of lettuce to the acre and then planted a cucumber crop and produced on an average of 600 crates of that fine money crop. In other words, they shipped two cars of lettuce for each acre planted and as 400 crates is a minimum ear load, we observe that their crop per acre was 800 crates of lettuce in addition to their later crop of 600 crates of cucumbers per acre, be it remembered. After the two former crops had been harvested, the land was sown in peas and just what their forage crop was we have not learned. However as this is a pea-producing country, it can be imagined that they will reap a third profitable crop from their well-tilled acres.—Wilmington Star.


