SAYS FEDERAL ROAD MONEY IS WASTED

Washington, Sept. 13.—There is a lurking notion in Washington that a lot of the Federal aid money for highways is being wasted in many of the States. Possibly this impression is partly due to the fact Senators and Representatives are prevented from giving their physical presence to the demonstrations of efficiency made by Federal, State and District inspectors whose business it is to check up on the work of county and town highway officials. In any event there is a good deal of the "I want to be shown" sentiment in the National Capital. Senator King of Utah, says that the State road organizations have received from the Government, various road building equipment and motor driven vehicles, valued in excess of \$100,000,000. A bill for an additional \$75,000,000 of Federal aid money is in conference between the two branches of Congress, and before the money is voted the same Senator would like to have a general investigation of road operations throughout the United States to determine the truth of his claim that the appropriations made by Congress have been used and expended "in an extravagant and wasteful manner."

It is fair to say that the views of Senator King do not represent the general attitude of official Washington, and he will have plenty of trouble with his resolution, before he is able to convince his colleagues from States that have the best kind of roads that the work is not being well and conscientiously done.
