Plases Passengers.

For some time past passengers who wished to go to points on the Atlantic Coast Line, and in the southern portion of the State, have been greatly inconvenienced by a long stay at Orange City Junction, in waiting on connecting trains.

The Florida Railway Commission has received the recent order to the Atlantic Coast Line and East Coast Railway Companies, changing their schedules so that connections might be made for points on the East Coast.

The Atlantic Coast Line is commanded to change the schedule of passenger train No. 80, so that it will Tampa at 7:40 daily, or at such time as will enable it to arrive at Sanford at 12:20 p. m., and at Orange City Junction 1:10 p. m.

The East Coast Railway is ordered that its train No. 29 shall arrive at Titusville at 2:40 p. m. daily, but shall wait ten minutes longer for the arrival of their train No. 12 from Sanford if the same shall be delayed and will arrive within the same time that day.

Also that train No. 78 shall arrive at Titusville at 2:35 p. m., but shall wait ten minutes longer for the arrival of train No. 12 from Sanford if same shall be delayed. Also that train No. 12 shall leave Sanford at 12:25 p. m., but if the Atlantic Coast Line No. 80 is late, and will arrive within fifteen minutes of its schedule time, then train No. 2 shall wait its arrival and shall make connection with train No. 29 at New Smyrna.

It is further ordered that these schedules shall go into effect on April 15, 1906, and remain in operation until further orders from the commission.

By the above it will be seen that each road is required to do its share toward affording accommodations for passengers, who desire to make east coast connections. It will be observed also that not only is the East Coast road to hold its trains a reasonable time in case the connecting trains are late, but also that, having held their Sanford and Orange City Junction trains the required length of time, they must then not fail to connect with the main line trains at New Smyrna and Titusville. By this arrangement passengers are reasonably sure of getting to their destination.

CALL FOR DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY

In accordance with the call of the Democratic Executive Committee of the State of Florida, made at a meeting of that committee, held in the City of Jacksonville, Florida, on Saturday, February 24, 1906, the Democratic Executive Committee of Volusia County, Florida, do hereby issue the following call for a Democratic Primary Election:

The said Democratic Primary Election will be held at the legal polling place in each election district in Volusia County, during the hours fixed by law for holding elections, on Thursday, May 15, 1906, for the purpose of nominating all Democratic candidates for office, both State and County, to be voted for by the voters at the general election, to be held November 4, 1906, and those to be appointed by the Democratic government of the State and County, at the holding of the said primary election, and the time of holding the primary election, 1906.

It is further provided that a second primary election, where necessary to choose between the light of candidates, whose nomination shall not have been made by a majority vote at the first primary, will be held on Tuesday, June 12, 1906, and at such second primary election only such voters as were qualified to vote at the first primary election shall be permitted to vote.

These persons shall be permitted to become candidates before or to vote at or participate in the management of any primary election held by the Democratic party, who are white Democratic voters, and are qualified to vote at the Democratic party—Volusia County, Florida—who are, by the laws of the State, lawful voters of the district in which they offer to vote, who have paid their poll taxes legally, and do not less than ten days before the date upon which said primary election is to be held, and who shall, when challenged by any voter, pledge in writing under oath, before an inspector, his honor to abide by and support the result of said primary and vote for the nominees thereof.

Each voter qualified to vote in said primary election shall have a right to vote for the following candidates, to-wit:

- One Representative in Congress.
- Two members of the Supreme Court for term of six years.
- Two Railroad Commissioners.
- One State Senator.
- Two members of House of Representatives.
- One County Assessor of Taxes.
- One Tax Collector.
- One County Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- One Clerk Criminal Court of Record.
- One County Treasurer.
- One Supervisor of Registration.
- One County Surveyor.
- Five County Commissioners.
