





After passing hotel turn sharp right at Halifax River bridge, pass the hotel front and Santa Lucia orange grove and follow the River Road to head of river and "Number Nine" orange grove 11.6). Continue straight ahead following Haulover Creek. Turn left, crossing new canal on draw bridge (15.4). Follow road to Mound Grove, L. B. Knox's 100acre orange grove (16).
