State of Chihuahua,
Passengers Say.

LAREDO, Texas, Nov. 25—Lu-
rid descriptions of conditions
throughout the state of Chihua-
hua, controlled by Villa forces,
were given by passengers arriv-
ing here from that portion of the
Mexican interior today. Food
riots are an almost daily occur-
ance, it was said. With food sup-
plies cut off from the south and
with Villa and his government
unable to furnish food supplies
from the North, conditions are
deplorable. According to dis-
criptions people are dying in the
streets. It was believed that
if the entrance and conquest of
the Carranza forces was long
Chihuahua City would be strick-
en beyond immediate rehabilita-
