

**Articles of Incorporation of
The Puerto Townsite Company**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT: That We, Fred Walther, J. N. Stradley, Julius Edwin Wright and M. F. Lee, residents of the County of Quay, in the Territory of New Mexico, have associated ourselves together as a corporation, under the name and style of

THE PUERTO TOWNSITE COMPANY for the purpose of becoming a body corporate and politic, and in accordance with the laws of the Territory of New Mexico, we do hereby make, execute and acknowledge in this certificate our intentions to become a body corporate and politic under the provisions of said law.

First. The corporate name and style of our said corporation shall be "THE PUERTO TOWNSITE COMPANY."

Second. The principal office of our said corporation shall be kept and maintained in the town of Puerto, Quay County, New Mexico; that Fred Walther is hereby designated as agent who shall be in charge of said office.

Third. The object for which our said corporation is formed and incorporated is for the purpose of promoting, developing and selling the property known as the Puerto Townsite lots, and to buy, sell and deal in real estate, and to do any and all things requisite to accomplish said object.

Fourth. The total amount of capital stock of our said corporation shall be Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars, divided into One Hundred (100) shares of the par value of Thirty (30.00) Dollars each; the amount of capital with which our said corporation shall commence business shall be Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars.

Fifth. The name and post office addresses of the incorporators of our said corporation and the number of shares subscribed by each of said incorporators is as follows:

Sixth. The period of the duration of our said corporation shall be twenty (20) years.

Seventh. The business affairs and management of our said corporation shall be under the control of a board of directors, who shall be three in number, and shall have power to form a constitution and by-laws for the conduct of our said corporation business.

Eighth. The following persons shall act as directors of this corporation for the first three (3) months of its existence: Fred Walther, J. M. Stradley and Julius Edwin Wright.
