Articles of Incorporation of the HIGHLAND PARK ADDITION.

Know All Men by These Presents. That we, G. W. Evans, Jr., M. B. Goldenberg and A D Goldenberg, residents of the County of Quay in the Territory of New Mexico, have associated ourselves together as a corporation, under the name and style of

THE HIGHLAND PARK ADDITION for the purpose of becoming a body corporate and politic, and in accordance with the laws of the Territory of New Mexico we do hereby make, execute and acknowledge in this certificate our intentions to become a body corporate and politic under provisions of said law.

First. The corporate name and style of our said corporation shall be "The Highland Park Addition."

Second. The principal office of our said corporation shall be kept and maintained in the town of Tucumcari, New Mexico. G W Evans, Jr is designated as agent, who shall be in charge of said office

Third. The object for which our said corporation is formed and incorporated is for the purpose of promoting, developing and selling the property known as "The Highland Park Addition" to the town of Tucumcari, New Mexico lots, and to buy, sell and deal in real estate, and do any and all things requisite to accomplish said objects.

Fourth. The total amount of capital stock of our said corporation shall be Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00), divided into sixty shares of the par value of one hundred dollars each.

The amount of capital with which our said corporation shall commence business shall be Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00.)

Fifth. The name and post office addresses of the incorporators of our said corporation and the number of shares subscribed by each of said incorporators is as follows:
