PENROSE DIES OF HEART FAILURE

U. S. GOVERNMENT IS ENTERING NEW YEAR RICHEST IN WORLD

WASHINGTON, Dec. 31.—The United States government with a monetary wealth of \$4,211,000,000 enters the new year as the richest nation on earth. The government wound up its 1921 affairs tonight with a cash balance of approximately \$475,000,000 in the treasury. At the same time, the public debt stood at \$2,142,000,000, a reduction of about \$150,000,000 being effected during the year.
