"For a dessert try Emergency Puffs Drain canned peaches from their syr up and cut fruit in quarters," says Fannie Mer.itt Farmer in Woman's Home Companion for June. Mix and sift one cupful of bread flour, one half teaspoonful of salt and two table. spoonfuls of baking-powder level measurements. Moisten to a soft dough with milk. Butter individual moulds and drop a spoonful of the mixture in each, place a piece of peach in each and cover peach with another spoonful of dough. Steam ten minutes and serve at once.
