used in aiding the holding of the county and state shows shall be used in connection with the junior department of said county and state shows, and the contests in all school house shows shall be limited to specimens of poultry and eggs actually raised and produced by the school children attending each respective school house, and the contests in the junior department of each county show shall be limited to specimens of poultry and eggs actually raised and produced by the school children of such county, and the contests in the junior department of the state show shall be limited to specimens of poultry and eggs actually raised and produced by the school children of the state of Oklahoma.

Section 6. The expenditure of the money herein provided for to be used in the aid of shows at school house and county shows shall be made in accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by a board consisting of the President of the State Board of Agriculture, the president and the secretary of the Oklahoma State Poultry Federation, and the state director of poultry club work, or a majority thereof, provided that the rules and regulations prescribed by each and all of the county boards as herein provided for shall be subject to the approval of the state board. The money herein provided to be used in aid of school house and county shows shall be paid out by the county treasurer upon orders or warrants signed by the county superintendent of public instruction, and the money herein provided to be used in aid of the state show shall be paid out by the State Treasurer upon orders or warrants signed by the President of the State Board of Agriculture.

Section 7. The state director of poultry club work and the county farm demonstrator and the county home demonstration agent hereinabove referred to are the officers working in this state under the general direction of the United States Department of Agriculture in co-operation with the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College, and if for any reason there should be no one filling these positions, or any of them, in the different counties of the state, or in the state, such boards shall be deemed complete without such persons.

Section 8. The state board hereinabove provided for may, from time to time, as may be deemed proper, change the time of holding any or all of the various shows hereinabove provided for.

Section 9. House Bill No. 216, approved February 26, 1917, providing for certain poultry shows, is hereby repealed.

Section 10. For the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
