

Different Grades of Cotton.—For a long time Senator Smith has had an idea that the difference in the actual value of the different grades of cotton was not as great as differences arbitrarily fixed by the cotton exchanges and enforced in the interior markets of the south.

It is not perfectly clear that by this arbitrary rating of the exchanges the farmers of the south have been robbed of millions of dollars every year.

Senator Smith has secured an amendment to the present agricultural bill of \$100,000 to provide every shipping point in the south with a set of government standard grades of cotton together with a set of the gins.

When this is done the farmers can no longer be robbed as they have been in the past. Senator Smith's work since this time is going to revolutionize the rating of cotton in the interior of the exchange and the speculators know this, and that is why they are all fighting him.

Excess of Fertilizers.—In the early part of 1913 there was a sharp advance in the price of commercial fertilizers, particularly superphosphate and nitrate.

On March 1, 1913, Senator Smith introduced the following resolution, which was adopted: Resolved, That the secretary of commerce and labor through the bureau of corporations, be and is hereby directed to investigate the causes of the advance in price of superphosphate and nitrate.
