For some time the Anderson school board has been considering the question of improving the heating system in the schools of the city and at a meeting held at the office of E. C. McCants yesterday it was definitely determined that several of the school buildings would be supplied with steam heat...

The contract was awarded at a meeting of the committee in charge of this work, composed of J. D. Rast, J. A. Brock and W. H. Shearer. The old system in use at this school was found to be defective sometime ago and the board has merely been waiting until it could secure sufficient funds with which to carry on the work.

Bids were received yesterday from the Sullivan Hardware company, the Barr Hardware Company of Greenville, the Anderson Plumbing and Heating Company and the Anderson Hardware Company.

Members of the school board said last night that the work would be begun within the next few days, or as soon as the material arrived and the heating system would be ready for the inspection of the board by the time school opens in September.
