ARE THE OLD PAPERS TO BE SUPPLEMENTED?

In various parts of the State new papers were started during the campaign, and as far as we now recollect, each and every one claimed to be a special friend of the "people."

We believe a majority of those which were started last fall, have already closed their careers, and their obituary notices have been published.

Lately our friends of the "people" have appeared at various places, with what might be termed special pleading for favor on a particular class, by making war on another class.

It is well when any enterprise fails to give satisfaction, for new men and new enterprises to enter the field of competition. The public are generally better served, but the experiment is sometimes a costly one for those who venture.

As a rule new papers are started by men who are inexperienced in the practical business of publishing a newspaper, and whether they develop the elements of success or not, their first step was certainly a mistake.

If any man or company of men should come to the conclusion that they are "called" into the newspaper business at any particular railroad tank or rural village, he or they would find it cheaper and better to buy an interest in the old established paper, for the simple reason that if there is room for but one newspaper, or the newspapers already established, and if the ability and energy in the old and the new enterprises are about equal the new paper must finally go down because of the great advantage which old papers always have over a new paper.

Rival papers are generally public benefactors. They stimulate each other to their best efforts, but when one paper tries to crowd out the other, by underbidding in prices of work, they cripple themselves without doing anybody any good.

Old established papers must keep up with the procession or else expect young rivals to enter the field in an effort to answer a public demand.

The papers which expect to exist and establish themselves on class prejudice will certainly fail. Nothing short of answering a public demand will put a newspaper on a solid footing.

As a rule the "people" do not subscribe for newspapers. If they do, they soon rise to sufficient intelligence to be considered members of the educated class of their respective communities, who have no sympathy for the deception which would appeal to the ignorance and prejudices of the "people."

A newspaper which avowedly seeks to array the people against the intelligence and decency of the country must of necessity have a very limited field from which it must draw its own support.

Death of Dr. James C. Furman.

GREENVILLE, March 8.—This morning at 6 o'clock Dr. James C. Furman died at his home, three miles from Greenville.

For some days he had been ill with catarrhal affection and some complication of the heart. His advanced age gave little hope that he could stand a severe attack, though his family hoped he might rally, as he had done from previous attacks.

Dr. Furman was born in Charleston, Dec. 5, 1809. His father, Rev. Richard Furman, a revolutionary patriot, identified with the early history of the Baptist Church in Charleston and low country, imparted to his son a love for state and country which became a part of his life.

As a student at Charleston college, he was a peer of his fellows in zeal for the glory of his section. He commenced the study of medicine, but changed his plans in 1828, when he professed conversion to the Baptist faith, and was baptized by Dr. Basil Manly.

Feeling it his duty to preach, he began a course of theological study, and commenced his ministerial work before he was of age. He took part in great revivals in Edgefield, Beaufort and Robertsville. The celebrated Richard Fuller was one of the converts at these meetings. He served the Welsh Neck Church, Society Hill, and Second Baptist Church at Charleston.

In 1843 he became a member of the faculty of Furman Theological Institute, near Winnsboro. In connection with Professors Mimms and Edwards, he elaborated a plan for a broader system of education, which resulted in the establishment of Furman University in this city. He selected the site of the University at Greenville, and was made chairman of the faculty. Afterwards he was elected president, which position he filled till 1881, when he was succeeded by Dr. Charles Manly.

Dr. Furman preferred to hold the position of instructor of mental philosophy and moral science, rhetoric and logic, which position he filled at the time of his death. He was twice pastor of the Greenville Baptist Church, and for several years past has been pastor of country Churches. He was married twice, and leaves a widow and five children. He was a man of remarkable mental power, broad views and clear ideas. Firm and unyielding in his convictions, he was always gentle and kind towards opponents. He was loved and admired by all classes, and gloom is thrown over this city by his death. He will be buried Thursday.
