SHORT NEWS ITEMS.

The house, upon request of Hepburn, gave unanimous consent to set aside May 1 and 2 for the consideration of the Nicaragua canal bill.

A St. Louis firm has orders for a number of steam-drills for the Cinco de Mayo mine in the Edondidas.—Chihuahua Enterprise.

The school census which is being taken in the city of Chicago has proceeded far enough to indicate that the population of that city is very close to the 2,000,000 mark.—Albuquerque Citizen.

Australian advices chronicle the discovery of rich placer grounds at West-derburn, Victoria. John Boyd, the first man to stake the ground, unearthed a sixty-one-ounce nugget at two feet depth.

The Berlin correspondent of the Standard says he is informed that the main object of the Czar's visit to Moscow is to pray for a son. Pious Russians believe that such supplications are especially effective during Holy week.

John A. Dexter, one of the rich men of Cape Nome, passed through New Orleans today on his way to Washington where he goes as representative of the people of Cape Nome, to ask that the president establish courts and some sort of civil government.

News has reached here of the killing of Jordan Cooke at Acatlan, Oaxaca, Mexico. Cooke was in charge of a railroad construction gang. He was standing in a group of half a dozen men when a bandit rode up and fired several shots in the crowd, killing young Cooke.

Admiral George Dewey and his wife have been offered portraits in oil of themselves by President Charles M. Schwab of the Carnegie company, and M. Chartien, the French painter, has been commissioned by Mr. Schwab to do the work.

The Rev. Q. B. Wilson, one of the best known negro educators in the south and president of the Stillman theological institute at Tuscaloosa, Ala., was killed instantly Monday by lightning while talking over a telephone during a storm at that place.

Colorado sometimes assesses unproductive, unproductive claims at \$500 each; California, usually, at \$100 each, for taxation purposes. The figure on a producing property varies with the amount of common sense possessed by the county assessor.—M. & S. Press.

Operations were suspended today in the Three Rod mills of the Illinois Steel company in Joliet Ill. Between 600 and 700 men are thrown out of employment. It is rumored that the entire Illinois steel plant here, controlled by the Federal Steel company, will shortly be closed.

Democrats in congress are preparing to make a campaign issue of the proposition to elect senators by direct vote of the people, the majority by which the resolution providing for the necessary constitutional amendment was adopted in the house having encouraged them to believe that the issue will be a popular one.

For the week ended Sunday, April 7, Stratton's Independence produced 720 tons of ore, the gross value of which amounted to \$56,000. The average value of the ore mined was \$80 to the ton. The estimated net profit to the company amounted to \$41,000.—Review.

Figures about copper prices and production are always interesting. The total quantity of copper produced in the world in 1899 was 473,818 long tons, as against 434,339 long tons in 1898. Of the total quantity produced in 1899 the United States furnished 265,156 long tons, being more than one-half of the total production of the world.—Review.
