Through to Virginia Beach, without change of Cars. Passengers for Ocean View change at N. & W. Depot, Norfolk, Va.

Train leaves Byrd Street (Union) Station at 8:30 A. M. sharp. Returning leaves Virginia Beach at 7:00 P. M.; Ocean View at 6:50 P. M., and Norfolk at 7:30 P. M. Stops only at Petersburg and Suffolk. This is the only all-rail line from Richmond to these points. No hot sun-bath changes or bays to cross—only one change to Ocean View and that from the same platform. No change for Virginia Beach—cars go through, giving the excursionists 7 hours and 30 minutes at Virginia Beach; 7 hours and 30 minutes at Ocean View and 8 hours and 30 minutes at Norfolk.


