

**Hamilton-Mitchell Fight.**

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 3.—One of the most determined prize fights that was ever fought on this coast took place at Alviso, Santa Clara county, between Billy Hamilton of San Jose and young Mitchell of this city, both light weights. The first meeting between the combatants was on Sunday at San Rafael where the sheriff, however, appeared on the scene and stopped the proceedings before the men got into the ring. To-day, however, their rendezvous at Alviso remained secret and the fight went on without interruption. After twenty-three hard fought rounds in which both sustained severe punishment the fight was awarded to Mitchell on a foul. The match was with hard gloves for \$250 a side.

**Anti-Chinese Club.**

SANTA CRUZ, Dec. 3.—An anti-Coolie club was formed at Felton last night with between thirty and forty members.

**Marks of Respect.**

WASHINGTON, Dec. 3.—In accordance with the President's order all general government buildings were closed to-day as a mark of respect to the memory of the late vice-president. The public schools and many business houses were also closed and at noon there was a general tolling of bells. It was like Sunday. At the White House a few callers put in an appearance but were informed that the house was closed. The official part of the President was entirely deserted and the President and Col. Lamont spent the day in a private part of the mansion. Every public building is most profusely and appropriately draped in mourning and all flags are at half mast. The White House was never so well draped as to-day, the mourning emblems being imposing and suitable.

**The Bowers Case.**

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 3.—The examination of Dr. J. Milton Bowers, accused of poisoning his wife to get the insurance on her life, was commenced to-day before Judge Rix and after the testimony of one witness further hearing went over till to-morrow afternoon.

**The English Election.**

LONDON, Dec. 3.—The summary of the elections so far held show that 191 Liberals, 171 Tories and 35 Parcellites have been returned.

**Thebaw's Surrender.**

LONDON, Dec. 3.—The surrender of King Thebaw was unreserved. At first he wanted terms, but his request was refused and his unconditional surrender demanded. He then acceded to British demands.

**Donahoe's Will.**

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 2.—The will of the late Peter Donahoe who died last Thursday was made public to-day. After some minor bequests to friends and charitable institutions he leaves his widow one-third of the interest derived from the invested property and homestead on Bryant street. The residue is devised to his son, Mervyn Donahoe, and his daughter, the Baroness Von Schroeder. The estate is valued at twelve million dollars.

**New Military Orders.**

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 3.—One of the immediate results of General Sheridan's flying trip to New Mexico is an order issued by Secretary of War Endicott, detaching New Mexico from the department of Missouri and annexing it to the district of Arizona, with General Crook in command. News of this effect was received at military headquarters here to-day.

**Spanish Agitator.**

BORDEAUX, Dec. 3.—Senor Sorilla, the Spanish agitator, has started for Spain for the purpose of fomenting a rising in favor of a republic.

**Mexican Revolution.**

SAN FRANCISCO, Dec. 3.—The Call's Interyer, Mexico, special gives the particulars of the revolution now in progress in the state of Nueva Leon, the interests of Romero Subio, secretary of the interior of the United States of Mexico, and father-in-law of

President Diaz. Subia aspires to succeed Diaz in the presidency and is laying the foundation of his election by elevating such persons to high offices in different states as will use their influence for him in the election which takes place in about a year. The trouble arose from one of these changes being attempted in the governorship of Neuvo Leon.

**Affairs at Lima.**

LIMA, Dec. 3.—Ceceres is making an attack on the palace apparently from the direction of Bolivar square. An incessant sharp rifle fire is going on from the palace and its surroundings and occasionally the thunder of big guns is heard. The streets are deserted except by a few, who are curious to witness the proceedings. At 9:50 o'clock this morning firing was begun from Lima Merced tower. All the railroad trains and other traffic are suspended.

**The Caroline Dispute.**

MADRID, Dec. 3.—The new cabinet has accepted the Paris settlement of the Caroline question.
