W. L. Bailey and Sheriff Gabriel went down to the honorable and ancient pueblo of Tucson Wednesday.

Seventeen bars of Silver King bullion passed through here Thursday, on the way to San Francisco.

The Florence Social Club will give a dance every two weeks till the mercury reaches an uncomfortable altitude.

Herman L. Smith returned from Globe yesterday. He went thither to enjoy the collection of certain taxes.

The dance at the court-house hall last evening, under the auspices of the Florence Social Club, was well attended and highly enjoyable.

The Chinaman arrested Monday, for drawing a revolver on a Mexican, was released upon payment of costs, amounting, with attorney's fees, to \$50.

Two trains collided on the Southern Pacific, Wednesday, about fifteen miles west of Casa Grande, but no fatalities resulted from the accident.

The jury in the case of John Touey, charged with an attempt to draw a deadly weapon on John Ruckelhausen, disagreed, and the case was compromised by the former paying the costs.

A musical soiree was held at the residence of Mr. Walbridge, Pinal, Monday evening, and the guests were treated, in addition to very entertaining music, to a round of excellent refreshments.

Alex. Leblanc presented us with a fine piece of ore this week, from J. V. Wilson's Sonora mine. It assays over \$800 and will make J. V. a bonanza king in the "sweet bye and bye."

Mr. G. W. Penter, of Bodie, California, has been awarded the contract for hauling the ore from the Pinal Consolidated mines to their smelter at Butte. The contract runs for nine months.

The Pinal Consolidated Company is still delayed in the erection of its smelter and buildings by the slow arrival of the material from Casa Grande, the latter occasioned by the scarcity of freight teams.

General Manager Linkton, of the Pinal Consolidated, has gone up to the Deer Creek coal fields, and to the South Pioneer saw-mill. He will take a look at the entire country in that section before his return.

Jesse Hardisty has come out to commence work on the Mark Twain claim at Mineral Hill. It is located on the Wedge and Cholla ledge, and shows some of the finest horn silver ore to be found in the Territory.

The Lewis Mining Company, composed of officials of the Central Pacific railroad company, has bought a half-interest in the Sunset and Cow-boy claims at Mineral Hill, and will commence work on them next month.

General Manager Linkton and Superintendent Dennis, of the Pinal Consolidated, spent the major part of the week at this mining camp, letting contracts and arranging other matters pertaining to the business of the company.

Members of the Florence Social Club will please remember that a club meeting for the transaction of important business will be held at the sheriff's office next Monday evening, at 8 o'clock, p. m. A full attendance is desired.

Mr. Geo. W. Penter, of Bodie, California, was here this week examining the road from Bellaire to Butte, with a view to bidding for the contract to haul ore from the Pinal Consolidated mines to their smelter.

Mr. Thos. Cochran, of Butte, spent the week at Florence. He has a power of attorney from Manager Linkton, of the Pinal Consolidated Company, to sell the town lots at Butte, and is doing a good business in that line. A large number of lots have been disposed of.

The iron cells and cages for the new jail are on the ground, and Mr. H. Stepperson, of St. Louis, is here to put them up. He was sent hither by Pauley Brothers pursuant to their contract. Messrs. Lane and Remy hauled the cells up from Casa Grande.

Arrangements are making to incorporate the Miller-Evill group of mines at Mineral Hill. These mines have been paid for, and as soon as the company can be organized development work will be commenced and continued without interruption till the mines are fully opened.

The Logan Brothers are running a tunnel on the Beutgard mine at Canyon de Oro, to tap the ledge 300 feet below the surface. The ledge shows a width of six feet on the surface and carries silver-bearing galena all the way across. Wm. Hunton is negotiating the sale of the property.

Charlie Palmer has returned to Florence with the intention of becoming a permanent resident. He has always had faith in the future of this place, and the improvement in the town during the past two months has strengthened his belief. Charlie holds a warm place in the hearts of Florentines.

While at Mineral Hill Saturday, we inspected the tunnel on the Rialto mine and found eight feet of splendid ore in the breast of the tunnel. This claim is the first south extension of the Specie Paying and has every indication of becoming equally as valuable and productive as any mine in the district.

Mr. Robt. Williams, of Silver King, was brought down to Florence last week for medical treatment and is quartered at the Lewis home. With the careful nursing of Mrs. Williams and under the skillful treatment of Dr. Harvey, he is doing well, and we hope to see him restored to his former good health soon.

Mrs. Geo. H. Sisson and wife, of San Francisco, Mr. John J. Safely and wife, of New York, Capt. D. B. Hamilton and wife, of Waterbury, Conn., and Mr. G. Platt passed through here Wednesday, en route to Globe. These gentlemen are all prominent mining men and are interested in property in the Globe district.

Mr. Henry Watzlavzick, late of the firm of Smith & Watzlavzick, will leave for Texas, his former home, soon. Henry is a man in all the word implies, and we, in common with many others, regret that he has determined to withdraw from the community and county to build his home in another land. We hope he may prosper as well under other skies as he has here.

F. O. Wilkinson completed the sixty-foot shaft on the Ida mine, at Mineral Hill, last week, and left with a force of men for Oracle camp to commence work on some claims in that district belonging to himself and Los Angeles parties. The party will return to Mineral Hill at the end of a few weeks to work on the property of the Lewis company. The Ida makes a good showing in the shaft just completed.

Wm. Hunton claims to have discovered, not far from here, a mammoth tank seven feet long and two feet in diameter at the butt. The cavity in the large end of the tank is eighteen inches wide, he says. He desires us to keep secret the exact whereabouts of this wonderful tank, lest some curiosity collector should go and carry it off in his vest pocket before he has had time to go after it himself. William didn't state what kind of lemonade he had been drinking just before the discovery.

Messrs. Matt Cavness and P. B. Graham, of Pinal, reported at these newspaper headquarters this week. They came by way of Bellaire and Butte and report an excellent road from the former point to this place. The purpose of Mr. Graham's visit was to procure a lot of samples from the copper claims lying about ten miles above Florence, and in which he is interested. Mr. Culver, of Pinal, has taken a bond on the properties for sixty days with a view to placing them in the East. The surface ore carries 66 per cent copper.

Henry Scholusen received from the Sylvester ranch, Tuesday, ten head of the finest and largest beef cattle we have ever seen in the Territory. He butchered the

first one of the lot Tuesday afternoon, and it weighed, after being dressed, over eleven hundred pounds. The meat was a sight seldom to be seen; the fat in some places was at least five inches thick. He will drive in ten more from the same ranch next week. Any one not convinced of the fact that Arizona can raise the finest beef cattle in the world should sample the meat mentioned above.

We are indebted to Mr. Harry Holburn, of the South Pioneer camp, for some very handsome specimens from the recent rich strike in the South Pioneer mine. The ore sparkles with virgin silver and gives an average assay return of \$1,000 to the ton. The new strike was made on the 100-foot level, and the ore-body is five feet in width and shows the same wonderful richness all the way across. There is no disputing the fact that the South Pioneer is a marvelous silver mine and will soon assist in swelling the bullion out-put of Arizona.

The little camp at Cottonwood was exceedingly lively Saturday night. The prospectors and miners of the vicinity assembled at the cozy little home of Mr. C. D. Henry and spent the evening in music and social chit-chat. The guests were treated to refreshments, prepared by Mrs. Henry, in the style in which she only can prepare them. As a hostess Mrs. Henry has few equals. It is impossible to enter her house and not feel at home. There have been material changes in the appearance and life of Cottonwood camp since our last visit to the place. It has advanced to the dignity of two stores and a boarding house since then, and numerous tents have been pitched on the flat lying at the base of Mineral Hill. Viewed from the summit of the hill it looks like a phantom city.

Mr. H. B. Murray, formerly of Pinal, has bought the interest of Mr. Henry Watzlavzick in the mercantile house of Smith & Watzlavzick, of Florence and Casa Grande. This firm has been one of the most successful in the county and offers a practical illustration of what can be accomplished in this favored field by energetic, enterprising, careful and capable business men. Starting with a mere handful of goods, they have, inside of a few years, accumulated a small fortune and established a business almost colossal in proportions and resting upon a solid financial foundation. The new firm will be equally as successful, for Mr. Murray is a gentleman of exceptional business talent and ample experience, while the fine ability, sound judgment and thorough training of Mr. C. The board of supervisors were in session Saturday and Monday and transacted the following business: Awarded a contract to Aaron Mason for the building of a culvert across the public road at Silver King, said culvert to be six feet high, eight feet long and eighteen feet wide, and to be constructed of 14x14 timber, with good substantial abutments, and to cost \$800, \$400 of which is to be paid by the county, a bond of \$1,000 for the faithful performance of the contract was required. The bid of C. H. Beckwith to feed county prisoners at thirty cents per meal was accepted; the contract runs to July 1st, 1882, and a bond of \$1,000 for the faithful performance of the contract was required. The Florence and Butte road having been viewed by the board and found to have been constructed according to the terms of the contract, was accepted; Superintendent Dennis, of the Pinal Consolidated, appeared before the board and showed that the contract had been transferred to him by the original contractor, and asked the contract price, \$2,500, be paid over to him; a warrant for that amount was drawn in his favor, the citizens of Florence having paid in the \$1,130 subscribed by them.

Al. Smith, the darkey released here recently for want of prosecution, is in the toils of the law again, according to the following from the Phoenix Gazette: "Albert Smith, commonly known as 'Nigger Abe,' is an unfortunate colored individual whose rotund though not comely visage could be seen behind the iron bars of our county jail, for the major portion of the past year, is again in trouble, and the chances this time or that he will change his quarters to Yuma. To gratify an inordinate propensity for stealing, on Sunday night Abe 'prigged' a horse belonging to a Mexican resident of Upper Tempe. On Monday he was arrested by Deputy Sheriff Edwards, and that night a committee of citizens made an informal demand for his person, stating that they were tired of the old darkey's pranks, and intimated that they would fix him so he would steal no more. Mr. Edwards succeeded in getting a postponement of proceeding in this direction, and on the following day took his prisoner before Justice Priest, who held him to answer, with bail fixed at \$300. Abe couldn't plunk down a red, and as Mr. Edwards deemed it unsafe to keep him in Tempe another night, he was brought to this city immediately and incarcerated in the county jail."

Death of a Pioneer. Died at Florence, A. T., Feb. 28th, William W. Thompson, age 82 years and two months. He was born in North Carolina; emigrated to Alabama and from there went to Texas with the first party of colonists, with Stephen F. Austin in 1821. He served as a soldier in the war of the Texas revolution under Sam Houston, Fannier and Milam, and was the first man with his family to move to Austin, the present capital of the State. Upon the discovery of gold in California he closed out his business in Austin and was one of the first party of emigrants who came over the southern route. For several years he lived in Southern California, but he has lived most of the time since 1854 in Arizona. Uncle Billy, as he was familiarly called by his friends, was a remarkable man in a great many respects. His sight has been gradually failing him for some time past, but his intellect was clear to within a few hours of his death. He will be remembered by many old Arizonans as a good, kind hearted old man, who never willingly wronged any one. Peace to his ashes. B.
