The Grand Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of California will assemble in the public hall of the Odd Fellows' Temple, corner Seventh and Market streets, tomorrow morning in its thirty-eighth annual communication.

Since the last annual session, the order in this State has prospered greatly, the net gain in membership being nearly 1000, making the total membership at 27,600.

A number of new subdivisions have been instituted, as also several Rebekah Degree lodges, which branch of the order is prospering. There are now over 350 subordinate lodges in this State, and at least 130 Rebekah Degree lodges, with 10,000 members.

The Rebekah Degree branch of the total receipts were \$21,281, and disbursements \$17,467.98.

TRACING RUMORS.

The Board of Health Visits the Almshouse.

Although no Charges were Preferred, Witnesses are Sworn and Examined—Everything Found in Good Order.

Publicly was recently given to certain rumors concerning the manner in which the Almshouse was being conducted by the new Board of Health. Weavers, the successor of the late M. J. Keating.

The rumors covered rather a wide ground, and it was shown that of general neglect, and cleanliness in the almshouse, and the general drunkenness of the female inmates and lack of discipline in the male inmates.

To determine if there was any foundation for the charges, Mayor Ford, the Board of Health, consisting of Messrs. Fiske, Le Toumeur, Quisten and DeYoung, Health Officer, J. J. Kenney and the Board's Secretary, John Heesch, visited the Almshouse yesterday morning.

The visitors were received by Superintendent Weaver and Dr. Luntz, the resident physician, who escorted them into the institution. A close scrutiny of all the details was made, both as to the male and female inmates, and by many of the members.

As to the charge of lack of cleanliness, that was quickly disproved. The floors, wards, beds and bedding, utensils, crockery and kitchen appliances were all clean and bright.

As to the charge of general drunkenness, it was also disproved. The female inmates spoken to, either publicly or privately, expressed themselves as if satisfied with the treatment they received. This was especially the case in the female wards, where the inmates spoke most gratefully of Mrs. Weaver.

No exception could be taken to the appearance of the inmates, and on your inspection, however, it was noted that the female inmates on the road leading to the house from a little distance back, were in a state of intoxication.
