TRIAL OF NAUGHTON.

Self-Defense Will Be the Plea Made by the Accused.

A Curious Letter of the Defendant Put in Evidence - Exclusion of a "Police Court Record" Owing to Error.

In presenting the facts of the homicide effort of the prosecution on the trial of John F. Naughton for the killing of Marcus M. Herr was greatly aided yesterday by Attorney Deury for the defense, who objected to every material question asked. From the line of his cross-examination it is evident that the prosecution will be self-defeated.

Dr. Herr was again placed on the stand, and was asked by Attorney Deury whether a man with a heavy arched in his hands, both arms were upraised, could receive such a wound as that inflicted on the body of Marcus M. Herr.

Dr. James Simpson described the condition of the body when examined by him, and identified a photograph of the arm and head of deceased. The direction of the bullet after entering the arm was traced, and the examination was made on March 20, but it was impossible to tell from an examination of a wound such as that inflicted on the body of Herr whether or not the body was in motion at the time the wound was made.

A PERSECUTION CLAIMED. Attorney Deury claimed at this point that this trial was not a prosecution but the persecution by John A. Benson. He wished it made clear to the jury who it was that retained special counsel in this case. He therefore moved that this witness' testimony be stricken out. Overruled.
