MUNICIPAL GOAL.

Supervisors' Investigation of Ebets' Charges.

The Accusations Declared Not Proved and New Contracts Are Awarded to the Lowest Bidders.

The charges made by A. M. Ebets that the prices bid by coal-dealers who recently applied to supply the city with coal are lower than it can be had elsewhere, and therefore a lease of coal to the city was refused.

Messrs. Cook, Bunker and Levy of the Grand Jury and Chief Supt. of Public Works, who were present at the meeting, were then read by Mr. Ebets, according to the present contract, J. F. Lynch, agreed to supply Wellington at \$8.75 per ton, for a lot of 2240 pounds and West Harty at \$9.

Mr. Ebets then submitted a number of samples of coal obtained from the Alameda Corporation and County Hospital by his agent, Thomas Hoesch, by permission of the clerk at the city hall.

Thomas Morton, a coal-dealer, was then sworn in as an expert on the subject of coal, and testified that the coal which he had seen at the city hall was of the same quality as the coal which he had seen at the city hall.
