The whaling bark Ocean, Captain Marvin, arrived yesterday, after a passage of 20 days, from the coast of Alaska, bringing 4000 gallons of oil, 2300 pounds of bone and a quantity of fox, wolf and seal skins, consigned to E. W. Burton.
