

BLACKFOOT, IDAHO, BROUGHT TO GREAT EXCITEMENT.

Frank Hull and His Nephew Murdered a Short Distance From Town.

A Posse of Armed White Men and Indian Police Start on the Trail of the Renegades.

BLACKFOOT (Idaho), April 13.—Great excitement was created in the afternoon of the killing by Indians of two unknown white emigrants who were encamped a mile below this place. Nothing could be learned as to the cause of the tragedy. Their bodies were found by a party of men, and a number of Indians were seen taking to the hills east of town. Business is suspended, and the killing is being investigated.
