

BROAD THE VICTOR. A Setback for the Fire Department Bosses.

The application of Charles E. Broad for a writ of mandamus to compel the Board of Fire Commissioners to reinstate him as clerk of the Corporation Yard was decided by Judge Wallace yesterday. The decision was in favor of Broad.

The first witness called at the morning session was Fire Commissioner Martin, who was made to admit by Attorney A. J. Clunie that Maurice Schmitt had told him that Broad was reinstated under orders from Buckley and Kinney.
